

WHAT IS LÀBORA?

Overview

What is Làbora?

A programme born out of a **public-social partnership** led by the Barcelona City Council and 3 social sector federations, aimed at **improving the employability** of people at risk of exclusion in the city of Barcelona, by **empowering jobseekers** and **employers** through **training**, **counselling** and **support** to attain long-term working opportunities.


Why Làbora?

Due to the need to create a **collaborative**, **tailored** program addressing both **social** and **employment** challenges through a **community-based** approach that engages both jobseekers at risk and employers in the task of improving employability.



HOW DOES LÀBORA WORK?

Summary of methodology



Combined with:

- Constant data-based innovation projects (several on-going pilots), with a tailored innovation methodology.
- Embedded and external researcher involvement to boost knowledge transfer all across the board.
- Relational and collaborative dynamics that integrate diverse insights in decision-making



Làbora's evaluation of impact by an external team of researchers (press conference, May 2025)

KEY IMPACT STATS:



+60,000 participants since 2015 (70% women; 50% of +45)



+ 1,000 new placements every year
€4.5 for every €1 of public funds
invested (average 2015-2022)



- **+8%** probability of being employed when joining the programme
- **+12**% probability of getting a full-time job (compared to other programmes)

- Holistic approach and strong community-based approach, centred on people and their context.
- More efficient way to manage public employment policies
- Building of synergies through public and third sector shared leadership and collaboration.
- Increased self-confidence on people facing a job research process

WHAT MAKES LABORA DIFFERENT TO OTHER ALMPS

How we design and use data-based solutions

- Integrated, programme-wide cloud-based database, integrated with social services platform.
- Data and findings are an essential part of all decision-making processes, including participatory dynamics
 - We use QlikSense to generate cloud-based 'live' dashboards for all stakeholders.
 - We generate 155-160 data-based reports per month, and use diverse analytical tools as needed.
- Collaboration with academia and external reviewers: embedded researcher at the decision-making table.
 - Currently reviewing **system of indicators** to better define and track how we improve employability for participants through a relational approach.

Future scenarios:

- Use of AI for more efficient reporting in specific instances.
- Open data scenarios.
