Who We Are

- Founded in 2023,
officially registered as a cooperative in May 2025
- Membership model: every member works 3h/month; 1 member = 1 vote
- 325 members (goal: 400 at opening in Fall 2025)
- Inspired by La Louve (Paris), SuperCoop Berlin, FoodHub Munich, Le Nid (Geneva) and others

Our Mission & Practice



- Community-based food systems
- Strengthening regional supply chains (e.g. Hof Kaemena dairy, small bakeries)
- Fair access to organic, regional and affordable food
- Wholesale partners: Naturkost Elkershausen (dry goods) + NKK Bremen (fresh: dairy & fruit/veg)



Challenges & Solutions

- Fragmented logistics → Bundling via Naturkost Elkershausen (dry) & NKK Bremen (fresh)
- Low awareness → Neighborhood outreach & tastings
- Bureaucracy → Legal & network support
- Maintaining participation → Coordinator system for engagement

Value for GRAINS & Outlook

- Real-life test case for urban cooperative food systems
- Bridging values (democracy, solidarity) with operations
- Connected to national networks & European exchanges
- Store opening: Beginning of November 2025
