

Context





In Catalonia, the administration at any level (local, regional or statal) provides very little open data regarding childhood and adolescence.

There are a few sources, such as:

- Dades Obertes Gencat
- <u>Dades Obertes Departament de Drets Socials</u>
- Idescat Sistema d'indicadors sobre la infància i l'adolescència

According to GDPR and local laws, the data is regarded as highly sensitive and subject to strict restrictions.

GEDISI is a project for a web-based application to digitize the services that **FEDAIA's organizations provide for children and youths**. This will allow the handling and sharing of data at several levels. It provides:

- Data gathering and reporting standarized and coherent.
- Sharing data within the Organization, controlling access according to different profiles.
- Preparation of reports that organizations must provide for internal governance, the administrations and the public.
- Sharing data from the organizations with FEDAIA, for statistics and preparing field-wide reports.
